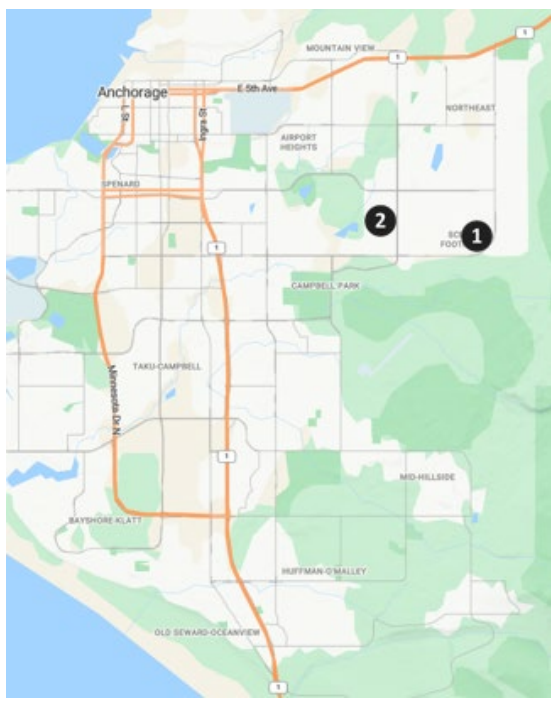

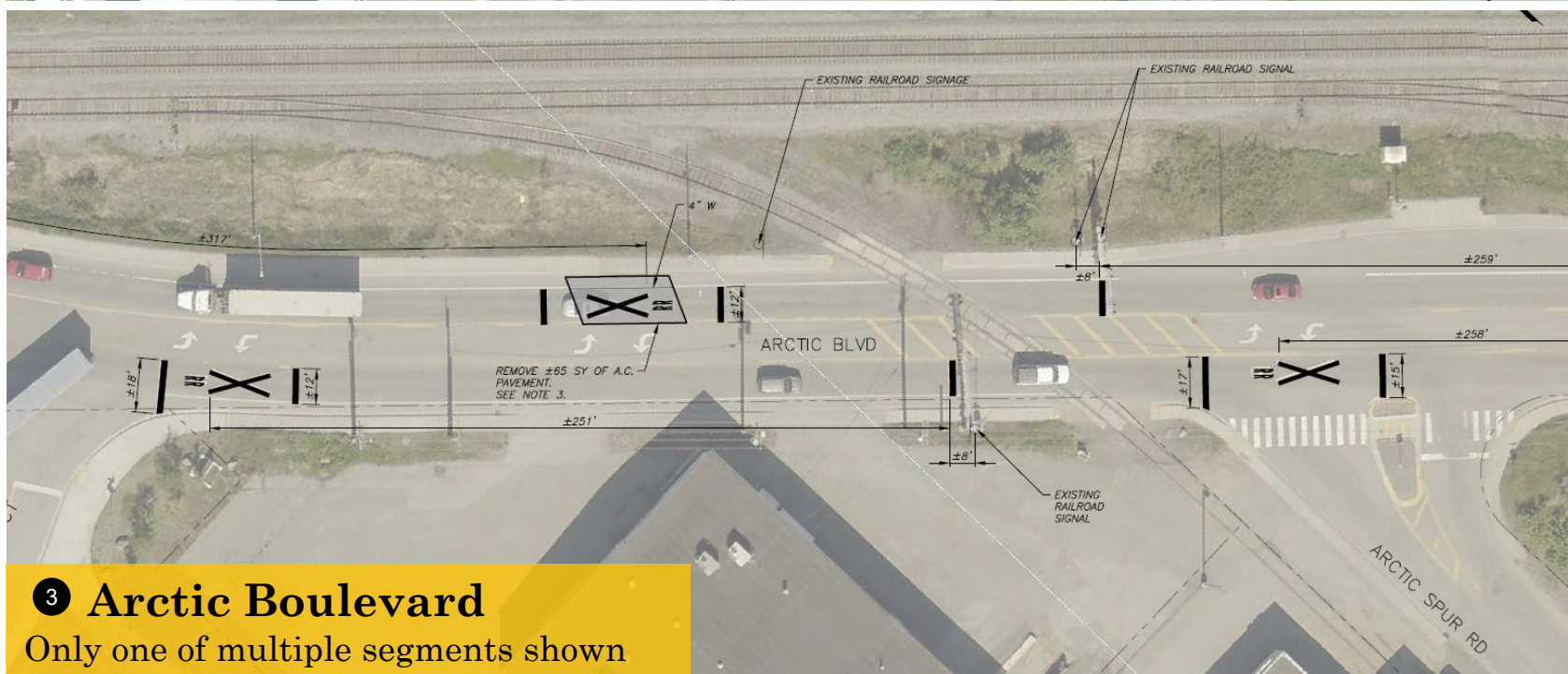


RXR Striping Project

2 Spenard Road Only one of multiple segments shown

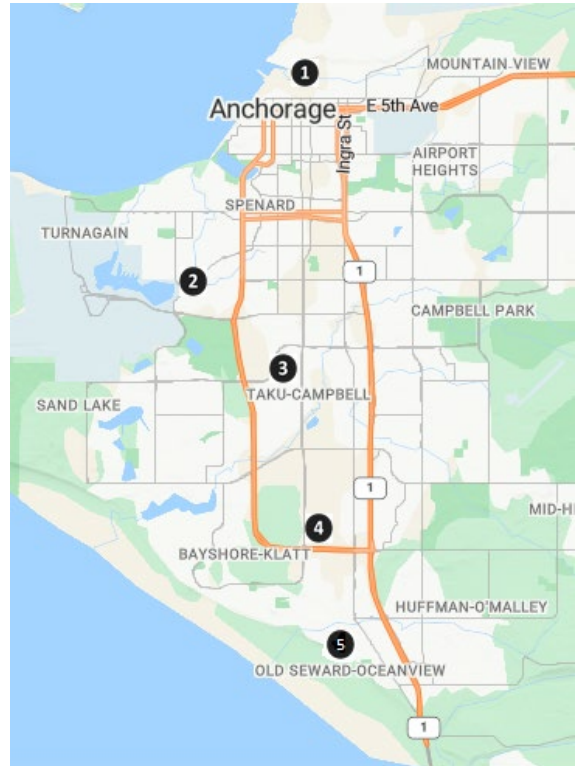
