



HOME Funding Spent Annually by Category





- New, more formal and transparent process for selecting projects
- Is the main way of doing allocations starting 2025

- Strategic Direction
 - Fewer but larger projects
 - Leverage other funds
 - Target biggest community needs
 - Housing supply
 - Supportive services

- For 2025:
 - RFGP for CDBG Housing/Shelter Acquisition
 - Grantee Selected True North Recovery
 - Specific project will be included in final AP draft

- Future Years (2026 on):
 - RFGP for Housing Acquisition
 - RFGP for CDBG Public Services
 - RFGPs go out before beginning of program year
 - Allocations through Annual Action Plan
