



#### Timeline

Program was set up in a very short time due to Treasury deadline

#### Complexity of Process

Multiple intake points for applications caused delays and increased workload

#### Approval Process

Delays going through multiple steps of process

#### Housing Market

Challenging to find available units to take short-term aid

## **Community Safety and Development Commitments**

- Transparency of spending for community
- More on-site visits and oversight of grantees and contractors
- Increased collaboration with community partners
