We are seeking proposals from community organizations, neighborhood groups, schools, and other local partners for **community-led projects that improve parks, trails, greenbelts, and recreation centers** in the Anchorage Bowl, Eagle River, and Girdwood. Projects must benefit public land and include meaningful community involvement.



Community Challenge Grants provide competitive funding to support projects that expand access to public lands, strengthen outdoor recreation, and encourage long-term stewardship of Anchorage's shared spaces. This program is managed by the Anchorage Park Foundation with generous grant funding from **Rasmuson Foundation**.

Applications are due by April 10, 2026.
