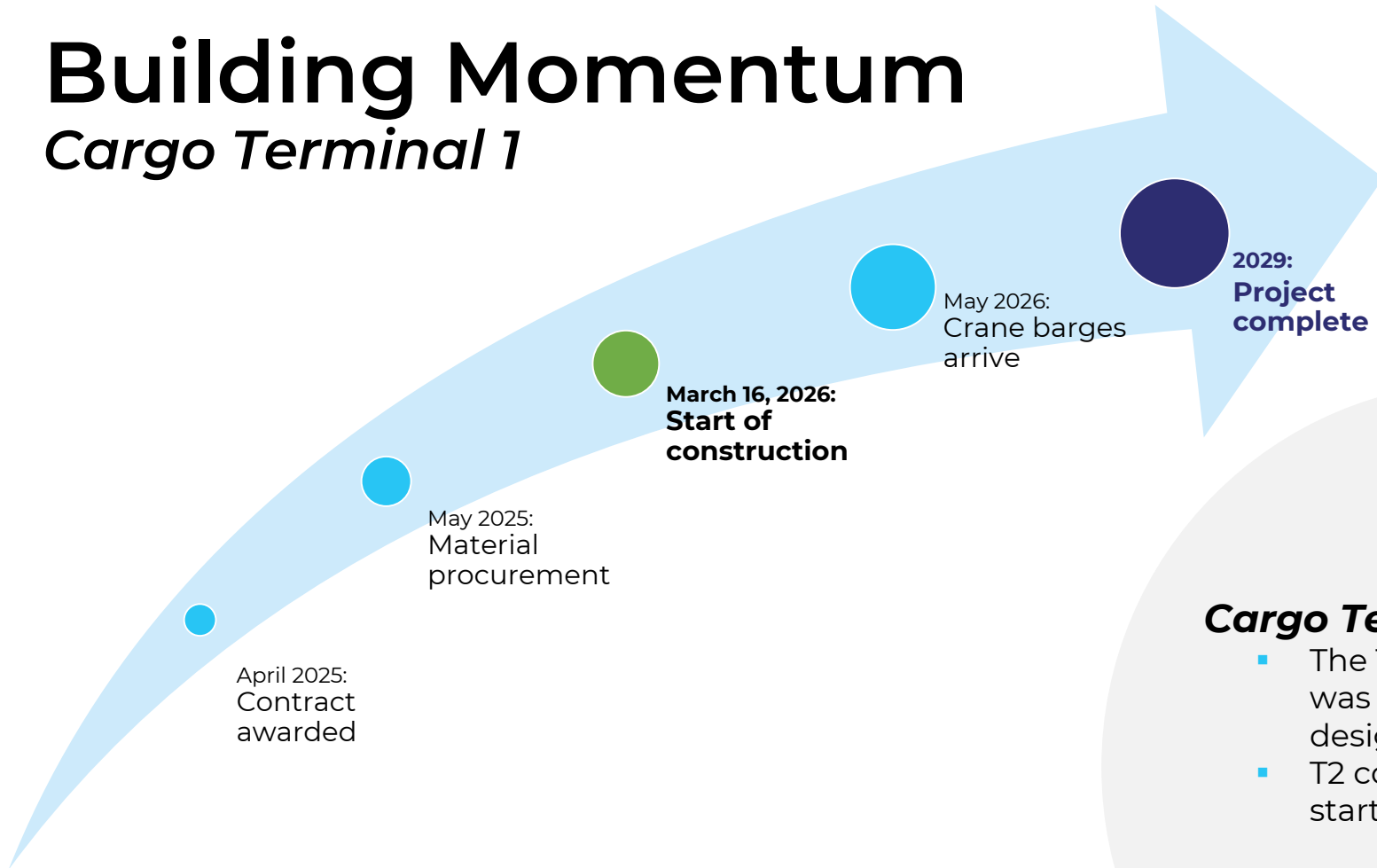

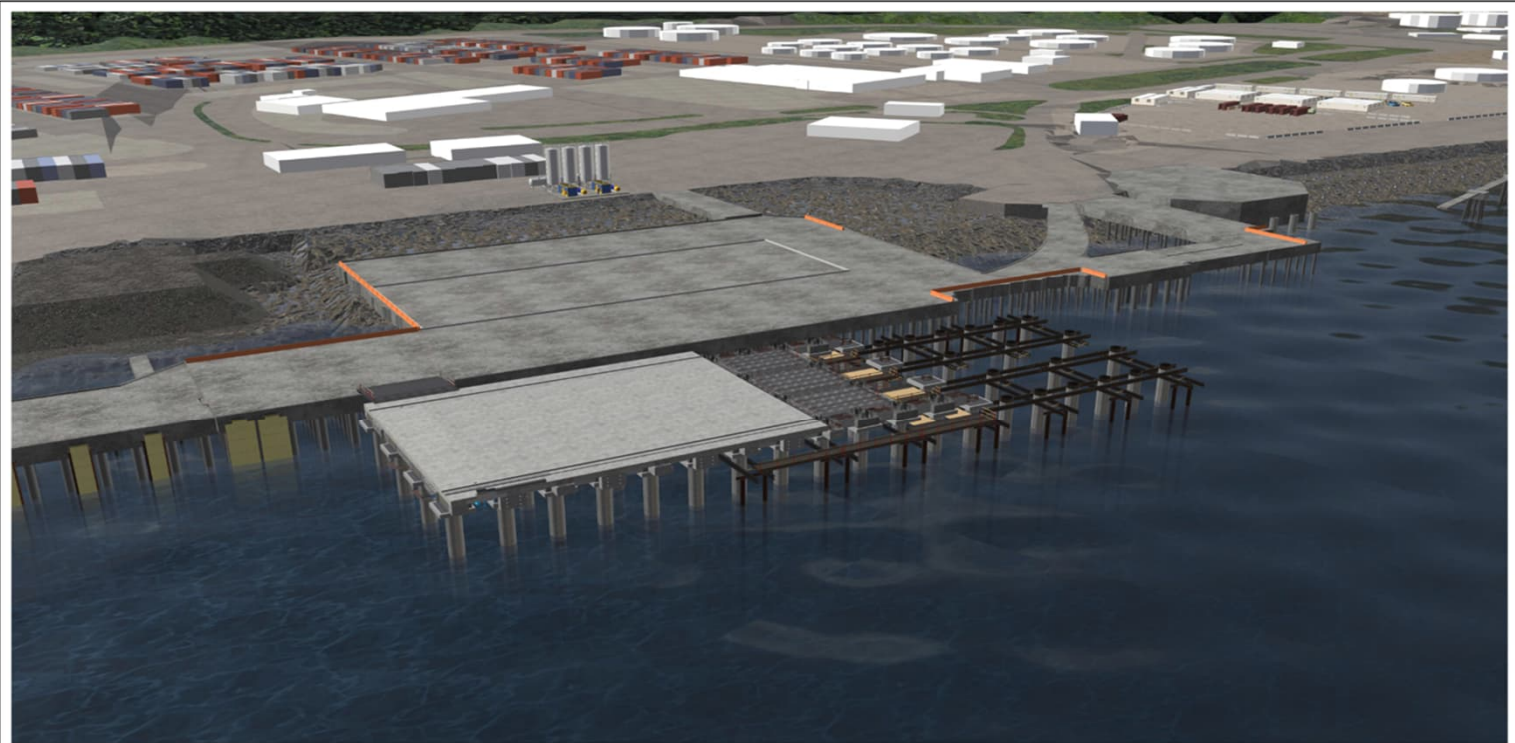

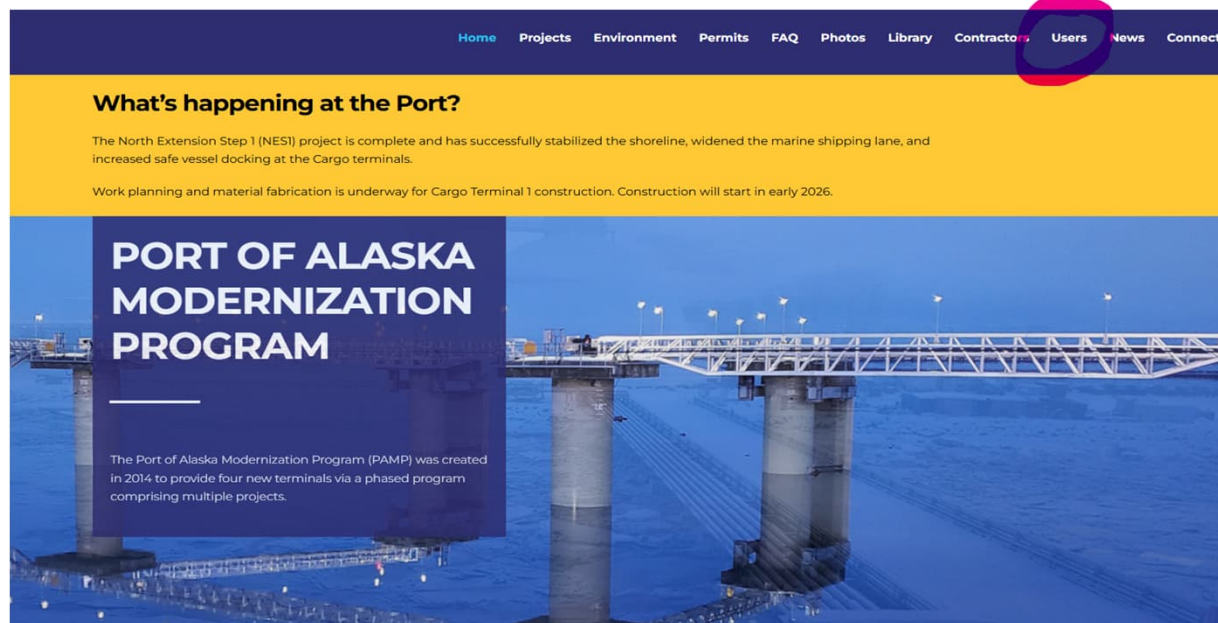

# CO Authority Increase to As Needed Energy Services

- Contractor: Geosyntec
- Original Contract Value: \$499,000
- CO Authority Increase Request: \$375,000
- Scope of work to be added
  - Solid Waste Services: Central Transfer Station Solar and Microgrid support in the amount of \$125,000
  - Waste to Energy Continued Support:
    - Basis of Design Advancement: \$100,000
    - Life Cycle Analysis (LCA) Assistance: \$50,000
    - Carbon Capture System Evaluation and Concept Development: \$100,000



# EPA clean grant award win

- Grant Value: \$1,399,906. See AM 209-2025
- 2 proposed subrecipients for this award.
  - Launch Alaska: \$667,266
  - GTI Energy: \$732,640
- Supports the following:
  - Baseline emissions inventory
  - Assessment of clean energy alternatives
  - Development of an energy transition plan
  - Evaluation of technical deployment scenarios
  - Workforce development
