Draft Recommendations for AO 2025-18

Recommendation 1: Deal with it now.

Approval of AO 2025-18 for placement on April 7, 2026, ballot.

Recommendation 2: Deal with it closer to the 2026 election.

Postponement of AO 2025-18 to the regular meeting of December 2 with a second referral to the Quality Municipal Services and Ethics and Elections Committee to conduct a final review at the November committee meeting.

Recommendation 3: Create a Charter Review Commission.

Indefinite postponement of AO 2025-18 with a recommendation that the Assembly consider a Charter Review Commission. Some example provisions of this commission could include:

- 9-member commission in line with the requirements of Title 4, Boards and Commission
- Has a clear sunset date
- Given the following topics for consideration as they make recommendations to the Assembly and Mayor:
 - Ideas within AO 2025-18
 - o Changing sales tax 60% threshold to simple majority
 - Exploration of who assumes the Mayor's emergency powers in the temporary absence of the Mayor
 - Filling the vacancy of the Mayor
 - Filling an empty seat of an Assembly member who becomes acting Mayor
 - Adding sexual orientation and gender identity to Article 17.01, Equal Rights
 - Six members to call a special meeting (currently at five)
 - Chief Equity Officer position and its reporting issues
 - Definition of total membership when one member is serving as an acting Mayor
 - Duties of an Assembly member

Recommendation 4: Not move forward with any Charter changes.

Indefinite postponement of AO with no further recommendation.
