JOHNSON AND OTHER LAW].

PROPOSED AMENDMENT

Purpose/Summary of Amendment: The purpose of the proposed amendment is to recognize that the public can lawfully possess construction materials on a street or sidewalk in order to, for example, carry it to a permitted construction site.

TEXT OF AMENDMENT

AO Section 2, p. 4, beginning at line 39, amending as follows:

- B. A person attempts to commit the offense of prohibited construction on public land if the person:
 - 1. knowingly possesses, on or in undeveloped land, snow disposal sites, or parks owned or controlled by the Municipality of Anchorage or the State of Alaska, ...
