AO Section 2, p. 4, beginning at line 39, amending as follows:

- B. A person attempts to commit the offense of prohibited construction on public land if the person:
 - 1. knowingly possesses, on <u>or in undeveloped</u> land, <u>snow</u> <u>disposal sites</u>, <u>or parks</u> owned or controlled by the Municipality of Anchorage or the State of Alaska, ...
