Assembly Members,

One more thing: during the worksession I mentioned in 1991 the Assembly voted down AR 91-142 and declined to find it was malapportioned, but I did not have the information that was the basis for that decision and was out of time to look into it further. This afternoon I located a related AIM 220-91 that I had not located previously, because it was referred to by no. only in the meeting minutes and not on the AR and other two AIMs with this item. This AIM presents the over/under data using the 1990 Census population information and concludes the total deviation was 10.1%. It seems apparent the body declined to find malapportionment on November 26, 1991, because it was an insubstantial degree of malapportionment. Subsequently by introduction of AO 91-182 (sponsored by Mr. Traini) at its next meeting and passed December 17, 1991 the Assembly made a slight change to existing district boundaries by moving precinct 125 from District 1 to District 4. The resulting total deviation after that change was 3.5%.
