

Right patient, Right place, Right care



High Utilizer

- Previous pilot program demonstrated positive results.
 - Cost savings
 - Time frame
- 3 or more calls to EMS in a 30-day period.

Opioid Response

- AFD responded to approx. 4 calls per day in which Narcan was admin.
- CORE facilitates connection to recovery resources via mobile response, including medication assisted treatment and follow-up with clients.
- About 8% of all transports in 2025 had some connection to opioid/drug use

Vulnerable Persons

- Elder care (e.g., falls at home)
- Victims of neglect
- Timely follow-up on EMS or APD related concerns for safety and wellness.
- Coordinate with hospitals on post discharge care.



Medication Assisted Treatment

- Sublingual Buprenorphine
 - Evidence based medication for opioid use disorder
 - Taken under the tongue as a film
 - Reduces withdrawal symptoms and cravings
- Who is eligible?
 - An individual experiencing opioid withdrawals
 - 16 years of age or older
 - Has not taken Methadone in the past 72 hours
- Goal is to connect individuals with long term community providers
