The Building

- New 36,732 sq ft facility
- The first large-scale mass timber project in Alaska
- Designed to be an intervention
- Partnership with HDR to incorporate evidence-based design into the facility







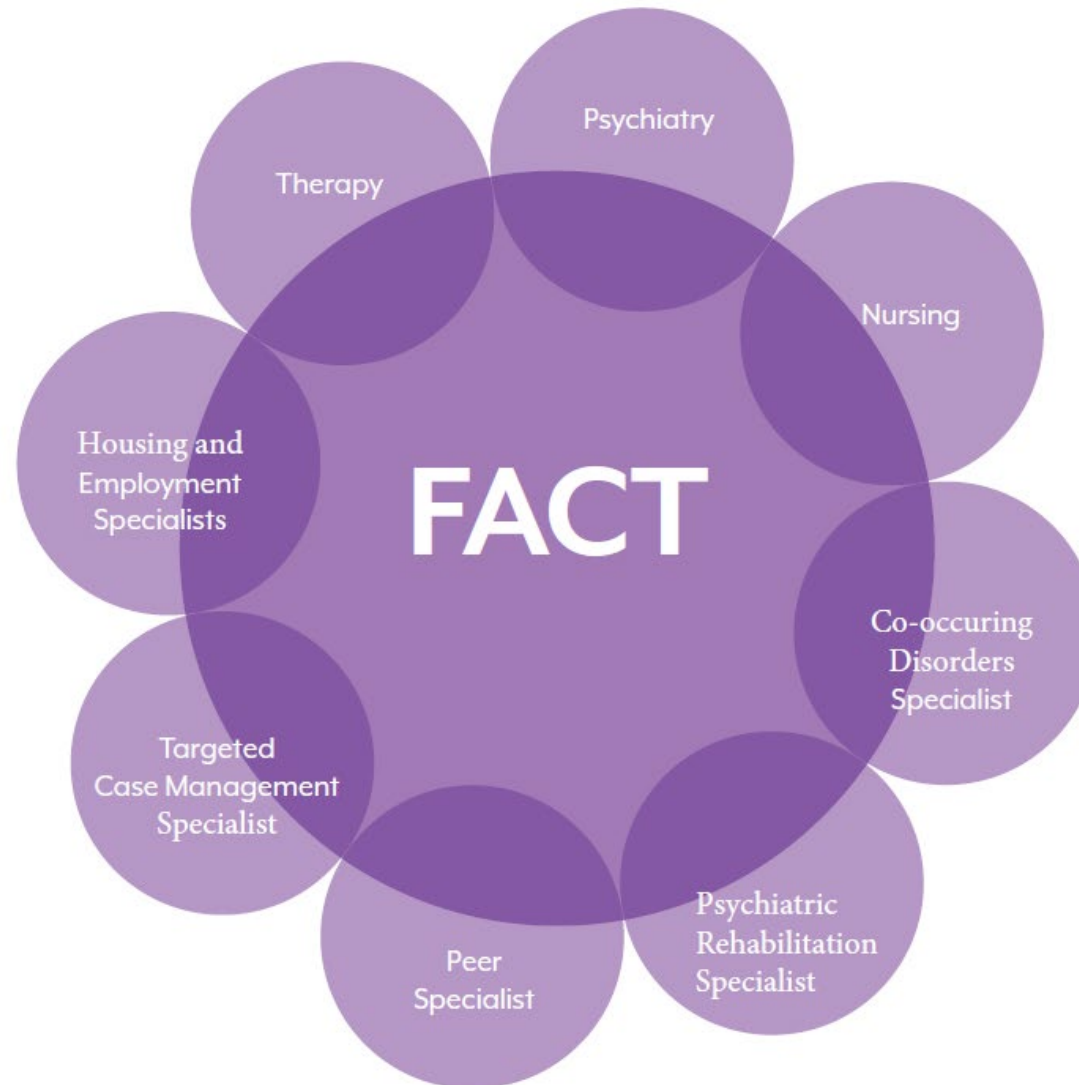


The Services

- Introduction of Flexible Assertive Community Treatment (FACT) to Alaska
- Doubling the number of staff employed to address the most complex behavioral health needs of our community
- Major investment in training and development of employees and significant shift in the types of employees doing this work.

- An example of what can be accomplished and scaled through partnership



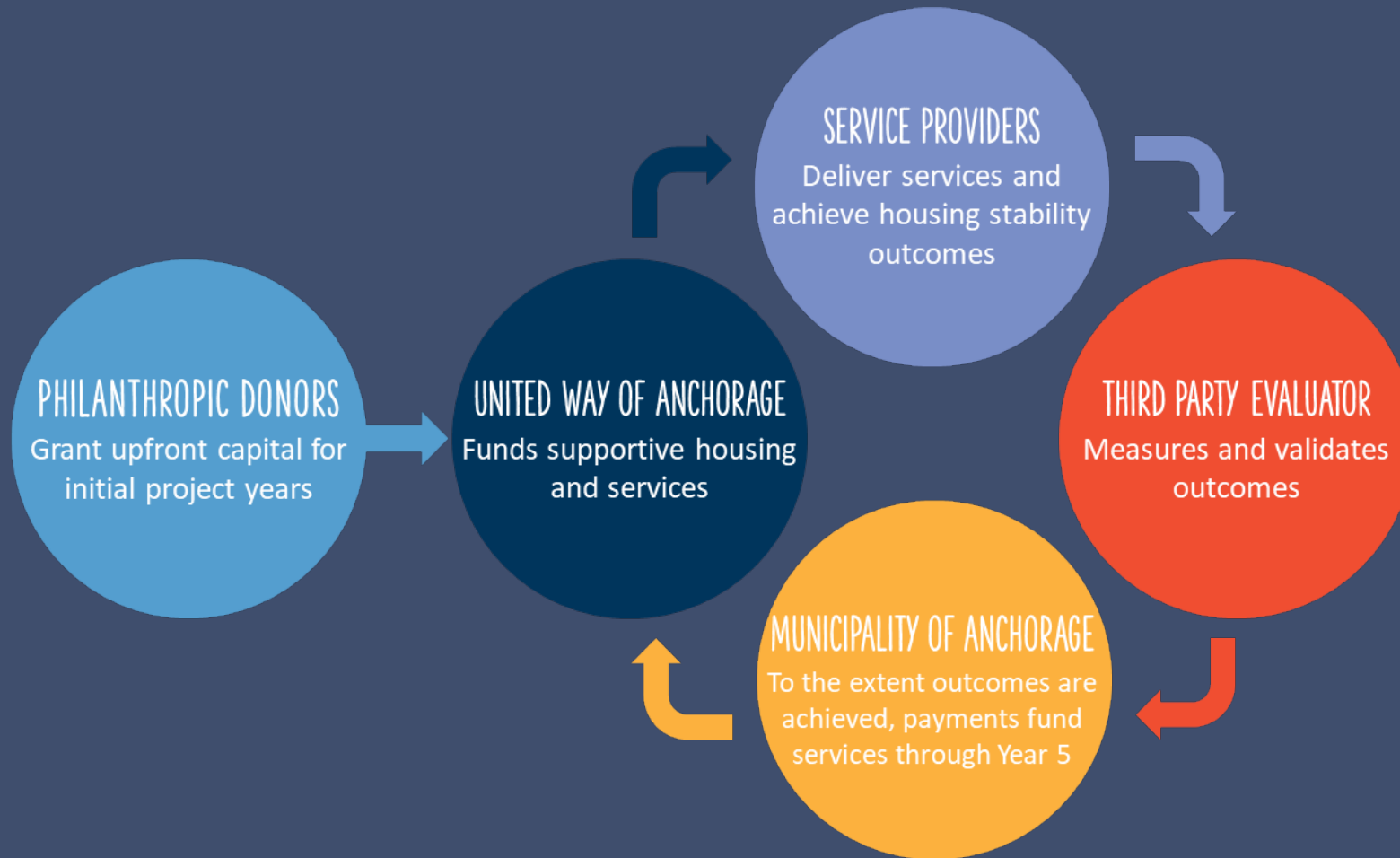

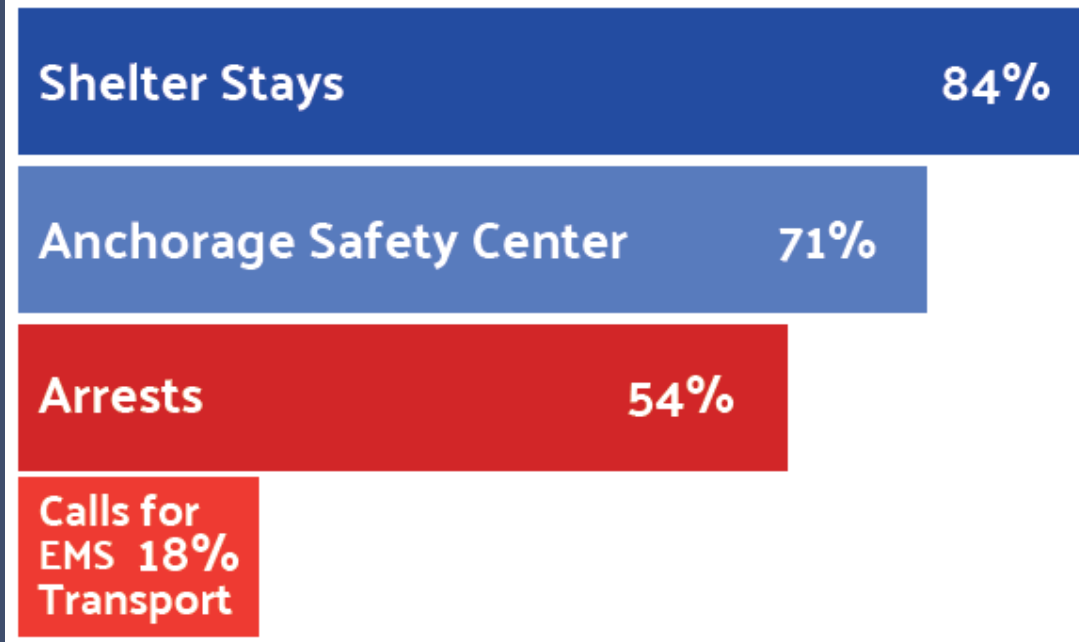
