- A variation of the COVID-19 stimulus package passed by the U.S. House was introduced in the U.S. Senate last night, assuming the U.S. Senate passes this new version, it will need to go back to the U.S. House for approval before going to the President's desk for signature
- Guidance to come out
- Treasury to deposit the money into the MOA bank account

What can we do before passage in Congress?

- Receive, review, and analyze reports on prior programs
- ☐ Meet with stakeholders on major programs likely to be replicated
 - Small business relief (to include variants like tourism and hospitality)
 - Rental and mortgage relief
 - Nonprofit relief
- Review framework and priorities
- ☐ Hold our first meeting to determine allocations

Timeline after passage in Congress

- □ 1 week after passage: Meeting to understand federal guidance, prep initial ordinance to allocate a small portion (20-25%) of funds
- ☐ 2 weeks after passage: Second (and hopefully final) meeting to determine allocations, begin public outreach, initial ordinance approved at a regular or special Assembly meeting
- ☐ 3 weeks after passage: Ordinance prepped for introduction at a regular or special Assembly meeting
- ☐ 4 to 5 weeks after passage: Ordinance approved at a regular or special Assembly meeting
