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


Alaska Foundation Formula

- All types of revenue on this slide have been converted to BSA-equivalent dollars
- FYs 22-26 are using 2% CPI as a historical average, though FY22 will likely be much higher



BSA Issue

- The statutory \$dollar amount of the BSA is more a legislative issue, or for legal standing of a collective group of school districts.
- AS 14.17.470: "The base student allocation is \$5,930."
 - ► Since July 1, 2016
- ► HB 272:
 - ► July 1, 2022 = \$6,153
 - ▶ July 1, 2023 = \$6,208
- ► HB 273, effective July 1, 2024:
 - ▶ July 1 each year: increase by % = average % increase in CPI-Alaska for 3 of prior 4 years

Basic Need formula - per school district

- District Cost Factor (AS 14.17.460)
 - Last updated factors: June 30, 2013
 - DEED to submit a report to Legislature Jan 15 every other year "proposed district cost factors."

District Cost Factor - Inequitable to Anchorage

- Basic Claim if the DCF were updated to reflect actual community costs, Anchorage's State Aid would be \$60M to \$100M more (rough estimate!)
- Harm/Injury Anchorage is unable to provide adequate education level to meet state policy that "all students will succeed in their education"
- Equal Protection DCF discriminates against Anchorage unfairly, real cost factors are not reflected in the DCF the state is applying, lacks a basis for it
- Remedy invalidate DCF currently being applied

District Cost Factor - Challenges

- ▶ 1. Proper Plaintiff's suffered the harm of the DCF inequity
- ▶ 2. Evidence that current DCF is inequitable to Anchorage quantifying
- ▶ 3. Anchorage vs. EE
- ▶ 4. Defenses

- ► 1. Commission an ISER Study (by ?).
 - ▶ 2005 and 2015
- ▶ 2. Information supporting a Legislative resolution
- ▶ 3. Engage Outside Counsel
