First, we looked at census data to figure out priority languages with the highest LEP populations.

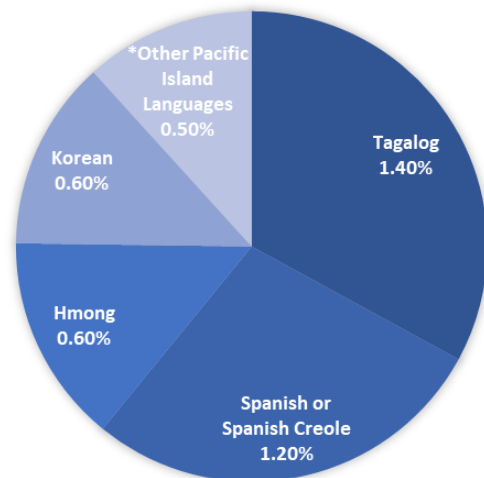
Now, each city Agency has identified and developed Language Access Plans to include translation and interpretation services for any person who may need them.
