AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE SUBMISSION TO THE QUALIFIED VOTERS OF ANCHORAGE, ALASKA, THE QUESTION OF THE ISSUANCE OF NOT TO EXCEED TWENTY-FIVE MILLION DOLLARS (\$25,000,000) OF GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE TO PAY THE COSTS OF EDUCATIONAL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE AT AN ELECTION IN AND FOR THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE ON APRIL 21, 1998

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY HEREBY ORDAINS:

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Section 1: It is hereby determined to be for a public purpose and in the public
 interest of the Municipality of Anchorage (the "Municipality") to incur general obligation
 bonded indebtedness in an amount not to exceed Twenty-Five Million Dollars
 (\$25,000,000) for the purpose of paying the costs of planning, designing, acquiring
 property for, site preparation, constructing, acquiring, renovating, installing and equipping
 educational capital improvement projects within the Municipality including, but not limited
 to the following:

33 Section 2: The sum of not to exceed Twenty-Five Million Dollars (\$25,000,000) 34 shall be borrowed by, for and on behalf of the Municipality for the aforesaid school capital 35 improvements and shall be evidenced by the issuance of general obligation bonds of the 36 Municipality. The bond proceeds shall be used for capital improvements only. The full 37 faith and credit of the Municipality is pledged for the payment of the principal of and interest 38 on the bonds, and ad valorem taxes upon all taxable property in the Municipality shall be 39 levied without limitation as to rate or amount to pay the principal of and interest on the 40 bonds when due. 41

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Section 3: An election is to be held on April 21, 1998, in and for the Municipality of									
Anchorage, for the purpose of submitting the following general obligation bond proposition									
to the qualified voters of the Municipality for approval or rejection. The proposition must									
receive a majority vote of those in the Municipality voting on the question to be approved.									
The proposition shall be substantially in the following form:

The annual increase in taxes on \$100,000 of assessed real and personal property value (based on the estimated 1998 assessed valuation) necessary to retire the proposed debt is \$15.20. The debt will be paid from individual and business property taxes levied and collected areawide in Anchorage. Anchorage will also pledge its full faith and credit for payment of the debt.
