AN ORDINANCE SUBMITTING TO THE QUALIFIED VOTERS RESIDING IN THE VALLI VUE ESTATES LIMITED ROAD SERVICE AREA AT THE REGULAR MUNICIPAL ELECTION APRIL 21, 1998 A BALLOT PROPOSITION APPROVING THE CONTINUATION OF SAID LIMITED ROAD SERVICE AREA FOR AN ADDITIONAL PERIOD OF THREE YEARS AND AMENDING ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 27.30.310.

WHEREAS THE Valli Vue Estates Limited Road Service Area was created by Anchorage Ordinance 83-81; and

WHEREAS a showing of interest in continuing said limited road service beyond December 31, 1998 has been made by persons residing in said limited road service area; now therefore,

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That a ballot proposition in substantially the following form shall be submitted to the qualified voters residing in the Valli Vue Estates Limited Road Service Area at the regular Municipal election on April 21, 1998:

CONTINUATION OF THE
VALLI VUE ESTATES LIMITED ROAD SERVICE AREA

Shall the existence of the Valli Vue Estates Limited Road Service area be continued for an additional period of three (3) years after December 31, 1998 until December 31, 2001?

1 SECTION 2. That Section 27.30.310 of the Anchorage Municipal Code
2 is hereby amended to read as follows:

4 There is a limited road service area within the Municipality
5 of Anchorage known as the Valli Vue Estates Limited Road Service
6 Area to provide limited road maintenance and repair to the area
7 described on the map located in section 27.30.700.
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9 Limited road maintenance and repair within the service area
10 shall [COMMENCE ON DATE OF CERTIFICATION OF ELECTION AND SHALL] end
11 on December 31, [1998] 2001, unless the service area is continued
12 [EXTENDED] by an affirmative vote of the service area [AFFECTED] at
13 the regular election of April [1998] 2001. The mill rate shall not
14 exceed 1.4 mill in any calendar year.
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
16 Section 3. Except for Section 2, this ordinance shall become
17 effective upon passage and approval. Section 2 and the proposition
18 contained in Section 1 shall become effective upon certification of
19 the regular election on the proposition called for by this
20 ordinance, but only if that proposition is approved by a majority
21 of the qualified voters voting on the proposition.
