AN ORDINANCE SUBMITTING TO THE QUALIFIED VOTERS RESIDING ON LOTS ABUTTING GLENN HILL CIRCLE EAST OF CHAPEL DRIVE AND SOUTH OF HILLTOP DRIVE IN EAGLE RIVER [LOTS ONE (1) THROUGH SEVENTEEN (17) OF THE GLENN VIEW SUBDIVISION] A BALLOT PROPOSITION TO CREATE A NEW SERVICE AREA DESIGNATED THE GLENN HILL CIRCLE STREET LIGHT SERVICE AREA TO OPERATE AND MAINTAIN STREET LIGHTS ALONG GLENN HILL CIRCLE AND TO AMEND ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 27.30.700 TO CONSOLIDATE THE NEW GLENN HILL CIRCLE STREET LIGHT SERVICE AREA WITH THE EXISTING EAGLE RIVER STREET LIGHT SERVICE AREA.

WHEREAS, street lights meeting Municipal standards have been installed and are operating on Glenn Hill Circle east of Chapel Drive and south of Hilltop Drive in Eagle River; and

WHEREAS, there is no mechanism for operating and maintaining street lights along Glenn Hill Circle except through a service area; and

WHEREAS, creation of a new service area approved only by the voters residing along Glenn Hill Circle followed by an automatic consolidation with the Eagle River Street Light Service Area by the Assembly provides a manageable and fair mechanism to accomplish incorporating the area into the Eagle River Street Light Service Area with no apparent adverse effect on residents in the Eagle River Street Light Service Area; and

WHEREAS, the services to be received in the Glenn Hill Circle Street Light Service Area are the same level of such services provided in the Eagle River Street Light Service Area; and

WHEREAS, there has been a showing of interest by residents on Glenn Hill Circle to join the Eagle River Street Light Service Area in order to provide for the maintenance and operation of street lights on said street; and

WHEREAS, it is in the public interest to provide for maintaining and operating street lights in the proposed Glenn Hill Circle Street Light Service Area; now therefore

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS:

**Section 1:** A ballot proposition containing substantially the following language shall be submitted at the regular Municipal election on April 21, 1998 to the qualified voters of the Municipality residing on lots abutting Glenn Hill Circle east of Chapel Drive and south of Hilltop Drive in Eagle River, such lots being Lots One (1) Through Seventeen (17) of the Glenn View Subdivision:


If creation of the Glenn Hill Street Light Service Area is approved, it will be automatically consolidated with the existing Eagle River Street Light Service Area. Property owners within the Glenn Hill Street Light Service Area will incur an increase in their property taxes to pay for the operation and maintenance of street lights in the new service area beginning with the tax year 1999.

**Section 2.** The Glenn Hill Circle Street Light Service Area consisting of all lots abutting Glenn Hill Circle, such lots being Lots One (1) Through Seventeen (17) of the Glenn View Subdivision, is hereby created effective January 1, 1999.

**Section 3.** Anchorage Municipal Code Section 27.30.700 is hereby amended by consolidating the Glenn Hill Circle Street Light Service Area consisting of all lots abutting Glenn Hill Circle, such lots being Lots One (1) Through Seventeen (17) of the Glenn View Subdivision, with the Eagle River Street Light Service Area as of January 1, 1999.

**Section 4.** Sections 1. and 4. of this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage and approval by the Assembly. The proposition contained in section 1. of this ordinance shall become effective upon certification of the April 21, 1998 regular Municipal election if, but only if, said proposition is passed by a majority of the qualified voters voting on the question contained therein. Sections 2. and 3. of this ordinance shall become effective January 1, 1999 if, but only if, the proposition contained in section 1. of this ordinance becomes effective.
