AN ORDINANCE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE AMENDING THE TERM "PRISONER" FOUND IN AMC 21.35.020 (B)

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS:

Section 1:

The term "prisoner" found in AMC 21.35.020 (B) is hereby amended to read:

Prisoner has the same meaning as defined in AS 33.30.901 as to state prisoners and includes persons convicted of a felony described in AS 11.41 (Offenses Against the Person) in Alaska or of an offense with the same or substantially similar elements in another jurisdiction until they have successfully completed all conditions of parole and probation and are no longer under the supervision of the court, the Alaska Department of Corrections, another state or municipal agency, or contractor to those entities. [AND AS TO FEDERAL PRISONERS MEANS OFFENDERS IN THE CUSTODY OR CONTROL OR UNDER THE CARE OR SUPERVISION] The term prisoner also includes federal offenders in the custody, control, or under the care or supervision of the United States attorney general or the bureau of prisons.

Section 2:

This ordinance takes effect upon passage and approval.
