AN ORDINANCE REPEALING AO 83-224 AND AMENDING THE ZONING MAP AND PROVIDING FOR THE REZONING FROM 1-2/SL (HEAVY INDUSTRIAL WITH SPECIAL LIMITATIONS) TO 1-2/SL (HEAVY INDUSTRIAL WITH SPECIAL LIMITATIONS) FOR A 6.70 ACRE PORTION OF TRACT D-1, TURNAGAIN INDUSTRIAL PARK SUBDIVISION, GENERALLY LOCATED ON THE EAST SIDE OF JOHNS ROAD AND NORTH OF EAST KLATT ROAD

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(Bayshore-Klatt Community Council) (Planning and Zoning Commission Case 98-051)

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THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS:

Section 1. Anchorage Ordinance 83-224 is hereby repealed.

- Section 2. The zoning map shall be amended by designating the following described property as I-2 (Heavy industrial district with special limitations) zone:
- 14 6.70 acre portion of Tract D-1, Turnagain Industrial Park Subdivision, as shown on exhibit A attached (Planning and Zoning Commission Case 98-051).
- Section 3. The zoning map described above shall be subject to the following listed
 restrictions and design standards (special limitations):
- Α. The owner of the property subject to this zoning map amendment shall construct 18 and maintain an earth embankment 20 feet wide across the top measured from 19 the near right-of-way line of Klatt Road and 80 foot wide measured from the 20 center line of Johns Road at an elevation along this longitudinal centerline not 21 less than 4 feet above the horizontal plane of the abutting right-of-way, except 22 existing wooded areas shall not be disturbed; the filled slope toward the north 23 and east shall have a maximum slope of 2 to 1. The top of the embankment and 24 the fill slope shall be prepared with suitable topsoil consisting of 60% of peat and 25 40% of sand, a minimum of 4 inches thick and hydroseeded with a mixture of 26 hardy grasses. The embankment and fill slope shall be densely planted with a 27 mixture of hardy deciduous and hardy evergreen trees, approximately 50% each. 28 Swamp spruce, also known as black spruce shall not be used. Each tree shall 29 be at least six feet tall; the trees shall be planted in staggered rows 30 approximately on 10 foot centers. The planting shall be constantly maintained 31 until established and hardy without maintenance. 32
- The above amendment only applies to a portion of the south Boundary of Tract D-1, Turnagain Industrial Park Subdivision, located along Klatt Road, and measuring approximately 165 feet west from the southeast corner of Tract D-1.
- 36 C. There is to be no access to Klatt Road from these properties directly or by way of Johns Road.

1	No natural resource extraction will occur on this site
2	Section 4. The special limitations set forth in this ordinance prevail over any
3	inconsistent provisions of Title 21 of the Anchorage Municipal Code, unless specifically
4	provided otherwise. All provisions of Title 21 of the Anchorage Municipal Code not
5	specifically affected by a special limitation set forth in this ordinance shall apply in the
6	same manner as if the district classification applied by the ordinance was not subject to
7	special limitations
8	Section 5. The Director of Community Planning and Development shall change the
9	zoning map accordingly.
10	Section 6. The ordinance referenced in Sections 1 and 2 above shall become effective
11	upon satisfaction of the following:
12 13 14	A. All buffer embankments and buffer landscaping as set forth in Section 3 above shall be developed and planted on Tract D-1, and reviewed and approved by Public Works - Building Safety.
15 16 17 18 19 20 21	B. The Director of the Department of Community Planning and Development determines that the special limitations set forth in Section 3 above have the written consent of the owners of the property within the area described in Section 2 above. The Director of the Department of Community Planning and Development shall make such a determination only if he/she receives evidence of the required consent within 120 days after the date on which this ordinance is passed and approved.
