19	to provide re	easonable guidelines and regulations to protect public health, safety, and				
20	welfare, and	to promote safe vehicular and pedestrian traffic; and

22	WHE	REAS, a recent tragedy involving the death of a young girl near an ice				
23	cream truck	prompted the Municipality to review its current guidelines and regulations				
24	for ice crean	n trucks; and

27	is important,	but given the fact that children are the primary patrons of ice cream truck				
28	vendors, it is	s imperative that the Municipality address the need for improved guidelines
