8 A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY PROTESTING THE
9 CONTINUED OPERATION OF A BEVERAGE DISPENSARY LIQUOR LICENSE AT 618
10 GAMBELL STREET, ANCHORAGE, ALASKA DBA THE RAVEN BAR

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13 The Anchorage Assembly finds that:

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15 WHEREAS, the Anchorage Municipal Assembly has received documentary evidence
16 pertaining to the continued operation of a liquor license; and
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18 WHEREAS, the evidence presented to the Municipal Assembly has raised material,
19 serious, and substantial questions relating to the ability of the licensee to comply with local and
20 State laws in the operation of the establishment; and
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22 WHEREAS, in accordance with AS 04.16.030 and AMC 2.30.125, the licensee has
23 failed to demonstrate compliance with the requirement of not allowing a drunken person to sell
24 or serve alcoholic beverages, in that on July 25, 1997, both the licensee and a bartender were
25 observed to be drunk on the premises; and
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27 WHEREAS, in accordance with AMC 2.30.125 D., the licensee has failed to
28 demonstrate the ability to maintain order and prevent unlawful conduct injurious to public
29 safety, in that on March 12, 1997, an assault was reported to the Anchorage Police
30 Department; also, according to the Metro Drug Unit, this establishment is well-known for illicit
31 drug activities; and
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33 WHEREAS, in accordance with AMC 2.30.125 H., the licensee has failed to
34 demonstrate the ability to prevent conduct which may be injurious to public health, in that on
35 July 25, 1997, a bartender was observed cleaning the toilets with a bar rag and then cleaning
36 the bar with the same rag.
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38 NOW, THEREFORE, the Anchorage Assembly resolves:

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40 Section 1: That for the reasons set forth above, the Municipality of Anchorage does
41 hereby protest the continued operation of the beverage dispensary liquor license at 618
42 Gambell Street, Anchorage, Alaska DBA The Raven Bar.
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44 Section 2: The Municipal Attorney is requested to take appropriate steps to use any
45 document or evidence necessary to effectively advance the position of the Municipality at any
46 hearing before the State Alcoholic Beverage Control Board.
