A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY CALLING UPON THE  
MUNICIPAL ADMINISTRATION TO DEVELOP A PLAN AND COST ESTIMATE TO  
CONSTRUCT A SKATEBOARD/ROLLERBLADING FACILITY NORTH OF TUDOR ROAD

WHEREAS, skateboarding and rollerblading have rapidly grown in popularity throughout  
the country, especially among our young people, many of whom have learned these sports on city  
streets, public places, and commercial areas; and

WHEREAS, given this popularity, the skateboarding/rollerblading industry has grown into  
a multi-billion dollar business; and

WHEREAS, within Anchorage, there is an active group of skateboarders and rollerbladers  
who need facilities to participate in these sports; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly is pleased that a skateboard/rollerblading facility is planned for  
the Klatt property development in South Anchorage; and

WHEREAS, a similar facility is needed to serve our citizens in the northern part of our city  
- north of Tudor Road.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Anchorage Municipal Assembly resolves:

Section 1: That the Assembly calls upon the Municipal Administration to develop a  
plan and cost estimate to construct an outdoor skateboard/rollerblading  
facility north of Tudor Road.

Section 2: That this plan and cost estimate be presented to the Assembly for review and  
consideration at the 1st Quarter 1998 budget revision.
