A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE, ALASKA, ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING ALASKA CLEAN WATER FUND LOAN OFFERS IN THE AMOUNT OF TWO MILLION TEN THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED FIFTY DOLLARS (\$2,010,650) FOR FINANCING A PORTION OF THE COSTS FOR FUEL TANK UPGRADES, WASTEWATER SYSTEM EXPANSION-1998, EQUIPMENT WASTEWATER-1998, WASTEWATER FACILITY REPLACEMENT AND REHABILITATION-1998 AND THE CHESTER CREEK SEWER TRUNK STUDY

WHEREAS, the State of Alaska (the "State") has, pursuant to Alaska Statutes 46.03.032 and 18 AAC 76.005 et seq. of the Alaska Administrative Code, U.S. Government grants as authorized by the Clean Water Act, as amended by P.L. 100-4; and;

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Anchorage (the "Municipality") is eligible to borrow from the Fund for the purposes of planning, designing, constructing, equipping, modifying, improving and expanding of public wastewater collection, treatment and discharge facilities; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly of the Municipality in its Ordinance No. AO 97-119 on October 7, 1997, determined it was necessary to proceed to plan, design, develop, construct, equip, acquire property for, or otherwise obtain items of capital improvements in connection with:

(1) Wastewater System Expansion-1998 (2) Equipment-Wastewater-1998; (3) Wastewater Facility Replacement and Rehabilitation-1998; and (4) Chester Creek Sewer Trunk Study, authorized the borrowing of an amount not to exceed \$2,010,650 (pro-rated amount for listed projects) from the Fund for the purpose of paying a portion of the costs of said projects; and authorized and directed the General Manager of the Anchorage Water & Wastewater Utility ("AWWU") to complete and submit to the State Department of Environmental Conservation ("DEC") applications to borrow monies from the Fund and to negotiate with the DEC the terms of such loans; and

WHEREAS, AWWU has submitted applications for loans in connection with the stated Projects, said applications for loans have been approved, and AWWU has negotiated the terms of these loans from the Fund totaling \$2,010,650 to pay a portion of the costs of the Projects; and

WHEREAS, the terms and conditions of said loans are contained in the Alaska Clean Water Fund Loan Agreements between the Municipality and ADEC entered into as of January 21, 1998; and

WHEREAS, it is hereby found to be in the best interest of the Municipality that said loan offers be accepted and that the Loan Agreements be executed on behalf of the Municipality.

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NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE, as follows:

Section 1. Loan Terms: The following primary terms of the loans which are among those incorporated in the Loan Agreement as hereby specifically approved:

Expenses of the System as those terms are defined in Ordinance No. AO No. 97-119; provided that if such monies are not sufficient, repayment of the loans shall be from any legally available funds accruing to or in the possession of the Municipality; and provided further that repayment of the loans are not a direct obligation of the Municipality and neither the faith and credit nor the taxing power of the Municipality are pledged

therefor.

Section 2. Approval and Executing of Loan Agreements: The Loan Offers in the amount of Two Million Ten Thousand Six Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$2,010,650) are accepted and appropriated and the Mayor with the Chief Fiscal Officer of the Municipality and the General Manager of AWWU, are hereby authorized, empowered and directed to execute and deliver the Loan Agreements for and on behalf of the Municipality, including necessary counterparts, and, from and after the executing and delivery of the Loan Agreements, the Mayor, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the Municipality and the General Manager of AWWU, are hereby authorized, empowered and directed to do all such acts and things and to execute all such documents as may be necessary to carry out and comply with the provisions of the Loan Agreements as executed.
