A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE AMENDING THE 1992 AIR QUALITY ATTAINMENT PLAN FOR ANCHORAGE, ALASKA.

WHEREAS, the Anchorage Assembly adopted the 1992 Air Quality Attainment Plan on December 8, 1992, and

WHEREAS, the Clean Air Act requires the air quality plans for all moderate carbon monoxide nonattainment areas to include contingency measures to be implemented in the event that the area fails to attain the federal air quality standard by December 1995, and

WHEREAS, Anchorage failed to achieve the air quality standard for carbon monoxide in 1996,

WHEREAS, the Environmental Protection Agency has given the State of Alaska and the Municipality of Anchorage the opportunity to revise the contingency measures currently contained in the Anchorage air quality plan, and

WHEREAS, the current contingency measures in the plan are less effective than originally envisioned or have technical or practical limitations that hinder their implementation, and

WHEREAS, an alternate contingency measure, the Technician Training and Certification Program, is an acceptable substitute for the measures currently contained in the air quality plan.

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:

Section 1. That the "1992 Air Quality Attainment Plan for Anchorage, Alaska" be amended by deleting the current contingency measures and replacing them with a substitute measure.

Section 2. That the narrative of the Plan be revised to reflect the changes described in Attachment 1 accompanying this resolution.

Section 3. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon passage and approval.
