A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY RECOGNIZING AND
HONORING VINCE FENNIMORE FOR HIS 24 YEARS OF SERVICE WITH THE MUNICIPALITY
OF ANCHORAGE

WHEREAS, in 1974, Vince Fennimore was hired to manage the borough's CETA Program
(now JTPA Program), a position he held until 1981; and

WHEREAS, in 1981, Vince was assigned to the Special Programs Division to oversee
animal control activities; and

WHEREAS, in 1986, Vince was transferred to the Environmental Health Division as the
Principal Administrative Officer responsible for housing, nuisance, noise, junk cars, I/M, and later
the division's customer service counter; and

WHEREAS, since 1985, Vince has taken the lead role in the Municipality's Spring Clean-
Up project; and

WHEREAS, Vince has superior talent for organizing and completing special projects, and
he is highly regarded for his expertise in budget, purchasing, ordinance development and
submission, and contract and grant development and tracking; and

WHEREAS, after 24 years of dedicated service, Vince is leaving Municipal employment
effective March 31, 1998.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Anchorage Assembly resolves:

That, on behalf of the entire community, the Assembly recognizes and honors

Vince Fennimore

for his 24 years of dedicated service to the Municipality - he will be greatly missed and his
shoes will be very difficult to fill.
