**A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY  
ENDORING THE BOARD OF REGENT'S REQUEST THAT THE  
UNIVERSITY OF ALASKA'S ANCHORAGE'S OPERATING AND CAPITAL  
BUDGETS BE FULLY FUNDED TO INCLUDE DEFERRED MAINTENANCE  
~~FROM THE UNDISTRIBUTED EARNINGS OF THE PERMANENT FUND~~**

WHEREAS, the community is aware that higher education for our students provides a source of wealth for our State; and

WHEREAS, the University of Alaska Anchorage is essential if Alaskans are going to determine their own destiny, instead of relying upon experts from afar who are not apt to have the long-term best interests of Alaska in their hearts; and


WHEREAS, if the University does not receive increased State appropriations, sports efforts and fine arts offerings will be lost, outreach to Alaska Natives will be heavily curtailed, and there will be a general reduction and shrinking of the University to a work-a-day mechanical school; and

NOW, THEREFORE, the Anchorage Assembly resolves:


Section 1: That the Assembly endorses the Board or Regents request that the University of Alaska's Anchorage's operating and capital budgets be fully funded to include deferred maintenance ~~from the undistributed earnings of the Permanent Fund~~.

Section 2: That, upon approval, copies of this resolution be forwarded to the House and Senate Legislative Finance Committees.
