A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE RECOGNIZING THE

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:

Whereas the promotion of health and quality of life for all through prevention is a major goal of our community; and

Whereas public health programs and services benefit everyone – regardless of race, ethnicity, and socioeconomic stratum – and are essential ingredients in a strong, successful community; and

Whereas public health activities protect all of us from infectious diseases, environmental and workplace hazards, chronic disease, unintentional injuries and violence; and

Whereas educating people about the benefits of adopting healthful behaviors can empower them to attain good health and prevent needless suffering and expense; and

Whereas public health workers in our community play crucial roles in ensuring that all of our citizens have the opportunity to be healthy people living in healthy communities; and

Whereas public health works to develop and implement sound public health policies that benefit the entire community;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Anchorage Assembly resolves:

Section 1. To celebrate the contributions of public health to the citizens of the Municipality of Anchorage during the week of April 6-12, 1998; and

Section 2. To continue to support the goal of improving the health and quality of life of the residents of Anchorage.
