A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY REQUESTING THE MUNICIPAL ADMINISTRATION TO TRANSFER MANAGEMENT AUTHORITY FOR THE PROPERTY KNOWN AS TRACT I, BAYSHORE WEST SUBDIVISION #4 FROM THE ANCHORAGE WATER & WASTEWATER UTILITY TO CULTURAL AND RECREATIONAL SERVICES FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEDICATING THE PROPERTY AS MUNICIPAL PARK LAND

WHEREAS, it is our understanding that the property known as Tract Bayshore West Subdivision #4 was given to the Municipality at no cost; and

WHEREAS, this property is currently an abandoned well site of the Anchorage Water & Wastewater Utility (AWWU); and

WHEREAS, the Municipality is currently in the process of offering this excess property for sale; and

WHEREAS, there are residents in the area surrounding this property - including a homeowners association - who are interested in developing and maintaining this land as a local park.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Anchorage Assembly resolves.

That the Anchorage Assembly requests the Municipal Administration to transfer management authority for the property known as Tract I, Bayshore West Subdivision #4 from AWWU to Cultural & Recreational Services for the purpose of dedicating the property as Municipal park land.
