A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY EXPRESSING
APPRECIATION TO CHARLES L. KANE FOR HIS 31 YEARS OF SERVICE TO THE
MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE UPON HIS RETIREMENT

WHEREAS, in May 1967, Charles L. Kane was hired by the Municipality of Anchorage,
(Greater Anchorage Area Borough), Department of Public Works, Street Maintenance Division,
as a Maintenance Man I; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Kane was promoted to Maintenance Man V on August 1, 1975, and
promoted again to Maintenance Foreman on October 2, 1978; and

WHEREAS, on August 5, 1985, Mr. Kane was reclassified to Street Maintenance
Supervisor, and on October 3, 1994, he was promoted to General Foreman; and

WHEREAS, during Mr. Kane's tenure with the Municipality:

He worked under six Mayors and eight Public Works Directors;

He received numerous "Atta-Boy" letters from the general public;

He contributed significantly to the maintenance, repair and safety of the Anchorage
Roads and Drainage Service Area Road System; and

WHEREAS, after serving the Municipality and its citizens for 31 years, Mr. Kane officially
retires on April 30, 1998.


NOW THEREFORE, the Anchorage Assembly resolves:
