~~WHEREAS, the Assembly has reconsidered all actions previously taken on the NE
Turnagain Assessment issue; and~~

~~WHEREAS, prior to taking any further action on this issue, an independent analysis
of the costs attributed to the assessments should be conducted.~~

NOW, THEREFORE, the Anchorage Municipal Assembly resolves:

~~Section 1. That the Assembly postpones any further action on the N.E.
Turnagain Assessment Issue, and recommends that Internal Audit conduct an
analysis of the costs attributed to the assessments.~~


Section 2.1. That within 60 days of passage of this resolution, Internal Audit shall
conduct an analysis of the N.E. Turnagain road, water and sanitary sewer
improvement districts to determine that all billed costs are within the scope approved
in the 1990 ballot and its attachments and provide the Assembly with a report of its
findings of fact, opinions, and recommendations.

~~Section 3. That, within 15 days of receipt of Internal Audit's report, the
Assembly shall re-visit the N.E. Turnagain Assessment issue, and take action it
deems necessary.~~
