ALASKA AR NO. 98- 133 A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY SUPPORTING A NEW EDUCATION ò FUNDING FORMULA 10 11 12 WHEREAS, the Municipality's highest legislative priority for 1998 is the school foundation formula 13 and 14 15 WHEREAS, in its 1998 Legislative Program, the Municipality encourages the State Legislature to 16 address the existing school foundation formula which has not been significantly revised for many years, and 17 urges the Legislature to work together with the Governor and School District in rewriting the formula so that 18 it will reflect a more equitable distribution of funding based on enrollment and programs; and 19 20 WHEREAS, Senate Bill 36 relating to the education funding formula has been introduced before the State Legislature; and 22 WHEREAS, SB 36 has passed the Senate and is currently in the House Finance Committee; and 24 25 WHEREAS, this bill should be viewed as a "starting point" for rewriting the education funding formula 26 and can be modified as necessary to effect a compromise between the State Legislature and the Governor. 27 28 NOW, THEREFORE, the Anchorage Municipal Assembly resolves 29 30 That the Assembly supports a new education funding formula, and views Senate Bill Section 1: 36 as a "starting point" for rewriting the formula. 32 That the Assembly encourages the State Legislature and Governor to effect a Section 2: 34 compromise on this legislation which will result in a more equitable distribution of funding and support to all districts. 36 Section 3: That, upon passage and approval, copies of this resolution be forwarded to the State Legislature and the Governor.
