A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY APPROVING A
CONDITIONAL USE FOR SALES OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES (BEVERAGE
DISPENSARY TOURISM LICENSE) LOCATED AT ORIGINAL TOWNSITE
SUBDIVISION, BLOCK 77, LOT 7A, GENERALLY LOCATED ON THE NORTH SIDE
OF WEST 8TH AVENUE AND BETWEEN "D" & "C" STREETS.

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:

Section 1. The conditional use permit for a beverage dispensary tourism license at
Original Townsite Subdivision, Block 77, Lot 7A, generally located on the north side of
West 8th Avenue and between "D" & "C" Streets is approved subject to the following
conditions:

1. A notice of Zoning Action shall be filed with the District Records Office within 120
days of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board's approval of the license.
2. All construction and uses shall conform with the plans and narrative submitted.

Section 2. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon passage and
approval by the Anchorage Assembly.
