A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE, PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT, TO FILE FOR A FEDERAL TRANSIT ADMINISTRATION SECTION 5303 METROPOLITAN PLANNING PROGRAM GRANT, ENTER INTO A TRANSFER OF RESPONSIBILITIES AGREEMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF ONE HUNDRED FIFTY EIGHT THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED TWO DOLLARS (\$158,502) WITH THE STATE OF ALASKA, DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND PUBLIC FACILITIES, AND TO APPROPRIATE THESE FUNDS ALONG WITH THIRTY NINE THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED TWENTY SIX DOLLARS (\$39,626) OF LOCAL MATCHING FUNDS FROM THE PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT'S CY1998 OPERATING BUDGET TO THE STATE CATEGORICAL GRANTS FUND (0231) FOR FINANCING OF THE TRANSIT PLANNING PROGRAM.

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES

WHEREAS, the United States Secretary of Transportation is authorized to make grants for Mass Transportation planning programs;

WHEREAS, the contract for financial assistance will impose certain obligations upon the Municipality of Anchorage, including the provision by it of a local share of the project costs;

WHEREAS, it is required by the U. S. Department of Transportation in accordance with the provision of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, as amended, the Municipality gives assurance that it will comply with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and the U.S. Department of Transportation requirements thereunder;

WHEREAS, it is the goal of the Municipality of Anchorage that minority business enterprises are utilized to the fullest extent possible in connection with this project and that definite procedures shall be established and administered to ensure that minority business shall have the maximum feasible opportunity to compete for consultant and other services contracts.

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY HEREBY RESOLVES:

Section 1. That the Mayor or Municipal Manager, or such other person or persons as the Mayor or Municipal Manager designates, is authorized to execute and file applications on behalf of the Municipality of Anchorage with the State of Alaska to aid in the financing of planning assistance projects pursuant to section 5303 of the Urban Mass Transportation Act of 1964, as amended.

1 Section 2. That the Mayor or Municipal Manager, or such other person or persons as  
2 the Mayor or Municipal Manager designates, is authorized to execute and file with such  
3 applications an assurance or any other document required by the United States Department of  
4 Transportation effectuating the purpose of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964.

6 Section 3. That the Mayor or Municipal Manager, or such other person or persons as  
7 the Mayor or Municipal Manager designates, is authorized to set forth and execute affirmative  
8 minority business policies in connection with this application's program of projects.

9  
10 Section 4. That the Mayor or Municipal Manager, or such other person or persons as  
11 the Mayor or Municipal Manager designates, is authorized to furnish such additional information  
12 as the State of Alaska may require in connection with this application's program of projects.



14 Section 5. That the Mayor or Municipal Manager, or such other person or persons as  
15 the Mayor or Municipal Manager designates, is authorized to enter into a Transfer of  
16 Responsibilities Agreement with the State of Alaska, Department of Transportation and Public  
17 Facilities, for the financing of the Transit Planning Program.

18  
19 Section 6. That a sum of one hundred fifty eight thousand five hundred two dollars  
20 (\$158,502) is appropriated as a grant from the State of Alaska, Department of Transportation and  
21 Public Facilities, when awarded, to the State Categorical Grants Fund (0231) for the financing of  
22 the Transit Planning Program.

24 Section 5. That a sum of thirty nine thousand six hundred twenty six dollars (\$39,626)  
25 is appropriated from the Areawide Fund, Public Transportation Operating Budget (0101) to the  
26 State Categorical Grants Fund (0231) to serve as local match.

27  
28 Section 6. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage and approval by  
29 the Municipal Assembly of Anchorage.
