WHEREAS, during Mr. Doucette's tenure, he has worked under six mayors, received many "Thank You" letters, and contributed to the maintenance, repair and safety of the Anchorage Roads and Drainage Service Area Road System; and

WHEREAS, after his dedication and service to the Municipality and the citizens of Anchorage for more than 28 years, Robert M Doucette will officially retire on April 30, 1998.


NOW THEREFORE, the Anchorage Assembly resolves:
