A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE PROVIDING FOR THE
ACCEPTANCE AND APPROPRIATION OF THIRTY TWO THOUSAND DOLLARS
(\$32,000) TO THE MISCELLANEOUS OPERATIONAL GRANTS FUND (0261) FROM
ALASKANS FOR LITTER PREVENTION AND RECYCLING FOR THE MUNICIPAL
COMMUNITY WORK SERVICE PROGRAM.

NOW, THEREFORE, The Anchorage Assembly Resolves:

Section 1. That a Thirty Two Thousand (\$32,000) Grant from Alaskans for
Litter Prevention and Recycling for the hiring of persons to assist in the supervision of the
Community Work Service Program and to operate the Youth Litter Patrol and Cigarette Butt
Patrol Program in 1998 is accepted.

Section 2. That the Thirty Two Thousand (\$32,000) Grant is appropriated
to the Miscellaneous Operational Grants Fund (0261) from Alaskans for Litter Prevention and
Recycling for the Municipal Community Work Service Program.

Section 3. That this Resolution shall take effect immediately
