**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE GRANTING OF A TAX REFUND TO  
KAREN MALCOM AS A RESULT OF MANIFEST CLERICAL ERROR ON  
BUSINESS PERSONAL PROPERTY ACCOUNT 500336**

WHEREAS, Karen Malcom was not the owner of record of the business personal property listed on account 500336 during the period including January 1<sup>st</sup> 1996, and

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Anchorage established an involuntary filing for assets not owned by Karen Malcom, and

WHEREAS, this listing constitutes a manifest clerical error, and

WHEREAS, Alaska Statute 29.45.500 (c) allows a governing body to correct manifest clerical errors at any time, and


WHEREAS, the amount of error for the tax years involved totals \$882.77 plus interest at 8 percent per annum to the date of payment.

NOW THEREFORE, the Anchorage Assembly resolves:

Section 1. That the sum of \$971.05 for principal and penalty plus interest at 8 percent per annum to the date of payment is hereby refunded to Karen Malcom.

Section 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage and approval by the Anchorage Municipal Assembly.
