A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY RECOGNIZING AND THANKING  
BRIGADIER GENERAL WILLIAM J. LAKE FOR HIS SERVICE, LEADERSHIP AND SUPPORT OF  
COMMUNITY ACTIVITIES DURING HIS TENURE AS COMMANDER, 3<sup>RD</sup> WING, ELMENDORF AIR  
FORCE BASE, ALASKA

WHEREAS, since November 1996, Brigadier General William J. Lake has commanded the 3<sup>rd</sup> Wing,  
Elmendorf Air Force Base, Alaska; and

WHEREAS, the 3<sup>rd</sup> Wing provides trained and equipped tactical air superiority forces, all-weather  
strike assets, command and control platforms and tactical airlift resources for contingency operations  
throughout the Pacific and Alaska; and

WHEREAS, the 3<sup>rd</sup> Wing also maintains a regional medical facility providing care for all forces in  
Alaska, including military retirees and their families; and

WHEREAS, Brigadier General Lake has nurtured and sustained strong civilian-military relations  
throughout the State of Alaska, especially in Anchorage by his leadership and support of community  
activities; and

WHEREAS, Brigadier General Lake will be leaving Alaska to command the 49<sup>th</sup> Fighter Wing at  
Holloman Air Force Base, New Mexico, where he will be responsible for the operation of the Air Force's only  
F-117A stealth fighter wing.


NOW, THEREFORE, the Anchorage Municipal Assembly resolves:

That the Assembly recognizes and thanks


