A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY RECOGNIZING AND THANKING BRIGADIER GENERAL WILLIAM J. LAKE FOR HIS SERVICE, LEADERSHIP AND SUPPORT OF COMMUNITY ACTIVITIES DURING HIS TENURE AS COMMANDER, 3RD WING, ELMENDORF AIR FORCE BASE, ALASKA

WHEREAS, since November 1996, Brigadier General William J. Lake has commanded the 3rd Wing, Elmendorf Air Force Base, Alaska; and

WHEREAS, the 3rd Wing provides trained and equipped tactical air superiority forces, all-weather strike assets, command and control platforms and tactical airlift resources for contingency operations throughout the Pacific and Alaska; and

WHEREAS, the 3rd Wing also maintains a regional medical facility providing care for all forces in Alaska, including military retirees and their families; and

WHEREAS, Brigadier General Lake has nurtured and sustained strong civilian-military relations throughout the State of Alaska, especially in Anchorage by his leadership and support of community activities; and

WHEREAS, Brigadier General Lake will be leaving Alaska to command the 49th Fighter Wing at Holloman Air Force Base, New Mexico, where he will be responsible for the operation of the Air Force's only F-117A stealth fighter wing.
