Stewart were the owners of record from 1989 through 1992 and Stewart Family Trust was the owner of record from 1993 through 1997 of the real property listed on account 014-162-20, and WHEREAS, a creek setback easement restricts the utility of the lot, and WHEREAS, the valuations of the property for 1989 through 1997 do not properly acknowledge that restriction, and WHEREAS, this oversight constitutes a manifest clerical error, and WHEREAS, Alaska Statute 29.45.500 (c) allows a governing body to correct manifest clerical errors at any time, and WHEREAS, the amount of error for the tax years involved totals \$2,689.72 plus interest at 8 percent per annum to the date of payment.
