

A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY RECOGNIZING AND HONORING HARRY A. LINSKENS FOR HIS 18 YEARS OF SERVICE WITH THE PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, on June 15, 1980, Harry A. Linskens began his employment with the Municipality of Anchorage working in the Transit Department as the Principal Administrative Officer; and

WHEREAS, during his tenure, Harry was consistent in performing his duties in an exemplary manner, and because of his efficient and innovative administration, the Department was able to save thousands of dollars; and

WHEREAS, Harry was also responsible for obtaining funding from the Federal Highway Administration, and the Federal Transportation Administration totaling approximately \$60 million dollars, and successfully completed six Federal Transit Administration triennial reviews; and

WHEREAS, Harry was responsible for the computerization of the entire Public Transportation Department, automation of a complex payroll system, voice information system, and computerization of the rideshare matching database; and

WHEREAS, on July 31, 1998, Harry retired from the Municipality of Anchorage Public Transportation Department after 18 year of service and commitment to the citizens of Anchorage.
