A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE ADOPTING THE 1999-2004 SIX  
YEAR FISCAL PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the Mayor has presented the 1999-2004 Six Year Fiscal Program for the Municipality of Anchorage to the Assembly in accordance with Article XIII, Section 13.02 of the Municipal Charter; and

WHEREAS, a duly advertised public hearing was held prior to adoption in accordance with Article XIII, Section 13.02 of the Municipal Charter; and

WHEREAS, the 1999-2004 Six year Fiscal Program provides a program for public services, fiscal policies, and capital improvements of the Municipality and presents options for addressing future fiscal requirements; and

WHEREAS, assumptions and projections contained in the Six Year Fiscal Program were developed with information that was considered the most reliable and current at the time; and


WHEREAS, Administration presentation and Assembly approval of the Six Year Fiscal Program does not constitute recommendation or approval of any of the presented alternatives.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Anchorage Assembly resolves:

Section 1. To accept the 1999-2004 Six Year Fiscal Program as a working tool for further consideration by the Administration, the Assembly, and the public to address options by which Anchorage municipal government can manage future fiscal requirements.

Section 2. That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage and approval.
