10 **A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY SUPPORTING THE MATCHING**  
11 **GRANT REQUEST FROM THE ALASKA CENTER FOR THE PERFORMING ARTS TO THE**  
12 **KREIELSHEIMER FOUNDATION FOR COMPLETION OF THE ELVERA VOTH REHEARSAL HALL**

15 WHEREAS, the Alaska Center for the Performing Arts is owned by the Municipality of Anchorage,  
16 and this world-class facility celebrates its 10<sup>th</sup> Anniversary during the 1998-99 performing arts season; and  
17

18 WHEREAS, the facility has several areas within it that are still not finished from original construction  
19 in 1988 - including two rehearsal halls; and  
20

21 WHEREAS, the theaters are very busy and available dates to rent them are dwindling; and  
22

23 WHEREAS, completion of one of the rehearsal halls - the Elvera Voth Hall - should be a capital  
24 budget priority for the Municipality for 1999; and  
25

26 WHEREAS, the Voth Hall completion project is estimated to cost approximately \$750,000; and  
27

28 WHEREAS, the Capital Matching Grant program awards 70% of the costs to the project but requires  
29 a 30% match; and  
30

31 WHEREAS, the Alaska Center for the Performing Arts, Inc. has made application for a major capital  
32 grant from the Kreielsheimer Foundation in the amount of \$225,000 for the 30% match to complete the Voth  
33 Hall.  
34

35 NOW, THEREFORE, the Anchorage Municipal Assembly resolves:  
36

37 That the Assembly supports the matching grant request from the Alaska Center for the  
38 Performing Arts to the Kreielsheimer Foundation for completion of the Elvera Voth Rehearsal  
39 Hall - a vital and needed part of the Alaska Center of the Performing Arts.
