1 A RESOLUTION ADOPTING AN ALLOCATION METHOD FOR THE FY99 SHARED FISHERIES  
2 BUSINESS TAX PROGRAM AND CERTIFYING THAT THIS ALLOCATION METHOD FAIRLY  
3 REPRESENTS THE DISTRIBUTION OF SIGNIFICANT EFFECTS OF FISHERIES BUSINESS  
4 ACTIVITY IN THE COOK INLET FISHERIES MANAGEMENT AREA

6 WHEREAS, AS 29.60.450 requires that for a municipality to participate in the FY 99  
7 Shared Fisheries Business Tax Program, the municipality must demonstrate to the Department of  
8 Community and Regional Affairs that the municipality suffered significant effects during calendar  
9 year 1997 from fisheries business activities; and,

10  
11 WHEREAS, 19 AAC 34.060 provides for the allocation of available program funding  
12 to eligible municipalities located within fisheries management areas specified by the Department of  
13 Community and Regional Affairs; and

15 WHEREAS, 19 AAC 34.070 provides for the use, at the discretion of the  
16 Department of Community and Regional Affairs, of allocation methods which may be used within  
17 fisheries management areas if all eligible municipalities within the area agree to use the method,  
18 and the method incorporates some measure of the relative significant effect of fisheries business  
19 activity on the respective municipalities in the area; and,

20  
21 WHEREAS, The Municipality of Anchorage proposes to join all other participating  
22 municipalities within the Cook Inlet Fisheries Management Area in an allocation method for FY99;  
23 and

25 WHEREAS, such allocation shall be fifty percent (50%) divided equally and fifty  
26 percent (50%) divided on a per capita basis;

27  
28 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, THAT the Anchorage Assembly by this  
29 resolution certifies that the allocation method fairly represents the distribution of significant effects  
30 during 1997 of fisheries business activity in the Cook Inlet Fisheries Management Area.
