**A RESOLUTION OF THE ASSEMBLY ADOPTING AN AMENDMENT TO THE AMATS 1997  
LONG-RANGE TRANSPORTATION PLAN TO ADD THE ANCHORAGE INTERNATIONAL  
AIRPORT LANDSIDE ACCESS IMPROVEMENT PROJECT**

2 WHEREAS, the Anchorage International Airport (AIA) Landside Improvement  
3 project is part of a larger terminal expansion project, and  
4

5 WHEREAS, the proposed roadway improvements are primarily designed to (1)  
6 reduce delays, confusion, and inefficiency and provide safe automobile access to  
7 the terminal, (2) increase the length of terminal's curbside drop-off and pick-up  
8 area, (3) improve merging and exiting movements on approach to and departure  
9 from the terminal, and (4) separate Postmark Drive traffic from South Terminal  
10 traffic and align roads to discourage access to the terminal via West Northern  
11 Lights Boulevard, and  
12

13 WHEREAS, the estimated \$26 million cost of the AIA Landside Improvement  
14 project satisfies the financial constraint requirements of the Long-Range  
15 Transportation Plan, and  
16

17 WHEREAS, the amendment to add the AIA Landside Improvement project  
18 will not require the LRTP to undergo a new air quality conformity determination  
19 since the project primarily involves changes in the vertical and horizontal  
20 alignments to the roadway circulation system in the area immediately adjacent to  
21 the AIA terminal.

23 NOW, THEREFORE, the Anchorage Assembly resolves:  
24

25 Section 1. That the amendment incorporating the Anchorage International  
26 Airport Landside Improvement project into the AMATS 1997 Long-Range  
27 Transportation Plan is adopted.  
28

29 Section 2. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon passage  
30 and approval by the Anchorage Assembly.
