**A RESOLUTION OF THE ASSEMBLY ADOPTING AN AMENDMENT TO THE
AMATS 1997 LONG-RANGE TRANSPORTATION PLAN CLARIFYING MAJOR
INVESTMENT STUDY PROCEDURES**

WHEREAS, the new federal transportation bill, The Transportation Equity
Act for the 21st Century (TEA 21), was signed into law on June 9, 1998, and

WHEREAS, one of the changes contained in TEA 21 allows changes to the
way Major Investment Studies (MIS) are conducted, and

WHEREAS, it is desirable to streamline Major Investment Study procedures
while at the same time retaining MIS principles.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Anchorage Assembly resolves:


Section 1. That the AMATS 1997 Anchorage Bowl Long-Range
Transportation Plan be amended to allow Major Investment Study principles to be
incorporated as a part of National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) documents.
However, this consolidation will only be used to include study principles and
procedures already required by NEPA or subsequently directed by the Secretary.

Section 2. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon passage
and approval by the Anchorage Assembly.
