A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE GRANTING OF A TAX REFUND TO SALLY S.  
AND JAMES V. BURKHOLDER AS A RESULT OF MANIFEST CLERICAL ERROR ON  
REAL PROPERTY ACCOUNT 011-121-79

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WHEREAS, Sally S. and James V. Burkholder were the owners of record from January 1993 through January 1, 1997 of the real property listed on account 011-121-79, and

WHEREAS, during this period of time the living area was listed on Municipal records as 2,720 square feet, and

WHEREAS, the living area was actually 2,266 square feet, and

WHEREAS, this overstatement constitutes a manifest clerical error, and

WHEREAS, Alaska Statute 29.45.500 (c) allows a governing body to correct manifest clerical errors at any time, and


WHEREAS, the amount of error for the tax years involved totals \$1,168.73 plus interest at 8 percent per annum to the date of payment.

NOW THEREFORE, the Anchorage Assembly resolves:

Section 1. That the sum of \$1,168.73 for principal plus interest at 8 percent per annum to the date of payment is hereby refunded to Sally S. and James V. Burkholder.

Section 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage and approval by the Anchorage Municipal Assembly.
