A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY RECOGNIZING THE 30 ANNIVERSARY OF THE ANCHORAGE MUSEUM OF HISTORY AND ART

34 WHEREAS, the museum received a "1998 Heart of the City Award" from the Anchbrage Downtown 35 Partnership in recognition of the year-long series of community events, public programs, and special projects 36 developed for its 30th Anniversary; and 37

38 WHEREAS, the video and public service announcement developed by the museum for its 30th 39 Anniversary recently received Gold and Silver Awards at the prestigious Emerald City Awards of the International 40 Television Association; and 41

42 WHEREAS, the museum has developed an outstanding volunteer program with over 20,000 hours 43 contributed to museum programs and projects in 1997, and three strong support organizations to strengthen its 44 unique public-private partnership. 45

NOW, THEREFORE, the Anchorage Municipal Assembly resolves:

That the Assembly recognizes the 30th Anniversary of the Anchorage Museum of History and Art, especially for the strength of its vision, the dedication of its leadership, the outstanding quality of its programs, and the great promise it holds for the future.
