The improvements authorized in Anchorage Ordinance 97-83 are 11 hereby deemed completed. Special assessments are hereby levied against the lots 12 and tracts specially benefited by the said improvements as set forth in the attached 13 assessment roll prepared for the district. 14 15 Section 2. Timely notice was sent to each property owner whose property was 16 specially benefited by the improvements as indicated on the assessment roll, and each 17 property owner was given notice of a public hearing before the Assembly for the 18 purpose of giving the property owners an opportunity to present objections to the roll by 19 showing errors and inequalities and by submitting any reason for amending or 20 correcting the assessment roll for the Paving Special Assessment District No. 4P97 21 West 5TH\6TH Avenue Alley from 'I' Street to 'K' Street. 22 23 Section 3. In conformance with the notice to the property owners, the Assembly 24 held a hearing on <u>January 12</u>, 1999, to hear objections to the roll by property 25 owners. At said hearing, all errors and inequalities to which valid objections were 26 raised, if any, were corrected and the amount now indicated on said special 27 assessment roll are the amount finally determined to be the amounts to be assessed 28 equal to or less than the special benefit to each property accruing from and which 29 the improvements constructed in said special assessment district. The assessment roll 30 has been duly certified by the clerk. Special assessments are hereby levied against 31 the lots and tracts specially benefited by the said improvements as set forth in the 32 attached assessment roll for the district. 33 34 Section 4. All assessments and installment interest thereon, may be paid in 35 approximately equal annual installments according to the schedule specified in 36 Anchorage Resolution No. 93-179. Annual installments are due and payable on or 37 before the <u>lst</u> day of <u>April</u> of each year, with the first such installment 38 coming due and being payable on <u>April 1</u>, 19 <u>99</u>. 39

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Section 5. Interest on the unpaid assessment shall be at the rate equal to the effective interest rate on the last bonds sold to finance similar improvements.

Section 6. Assessment installments not paid when due and payable are delinquent beginning on the day following the date when due and payable. A penalty of eight percent (8%) shall be added to any assessment installment not paid before the date of delinguency and both the penalty and the delinguent amount shall draw interest at the rate of eight percent (8%) per annum until paid.

Section 7. Within thirty (30) days from the passage of this resolution, the Municipal Treasurer shall mail, postage prepaid, a notice to any owner of property whose assessment, schedule of payments, delinquencies, or amount of penalty and interest has been changed as a result of the hearing on the assessment roll. Not more than sixty (60), or less than thirty (30) days before the date said assessment or the first installment thereof shall become delinquent, the Municipal Treasurer shall mail a payment notice to each property owner, but failure to mail such notice shall in no way affect any liability for assessment levied by this resolution.
