A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY SETTING A PUBLIC HEARING ON JANUARY 5, 1999 TO CONSIDER AND ACT UPON A PROTEST OF THE RENEWAL OF THE BEVERAGE DISPENSARY LICENSE AND DUPLICATE LICENSE FOR LLD, INC., d/b/a THE HUB, LOCATED AT 122 E. FOURTH AVENUE, ANCHORAGE, ALASKA.

WHEREAS, The Hub is a bar at 122 E. Fourth Avenue in Anchorage; and

WHEREAS, since 1994, the Assembly has repeatedly considered proposals to protest or condition the license of The Hub based on a pattern of violations of liquor laws and of failure to prevent violent crimes and drug possessions; and

WHEREAS, police incident summaries for the fourth quarter of 1997 through the fourth quarter of 1998 indicate that, despite previous second chances granted by the Assembly, the patterns of unlawful activity and violation of protest conditions at and by The Hub may have continued; now therefore,

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES

<u>Section 1.</u> A public hearing is hereby set for January 5, 1999 during the Regular Assembly Meeting in the Assembly Chambers to hear evidence and testimony and for the Assembly to take action on whether the Assembly should protest, conditionally protest or waive protest of the renewal of The Hub's beverage dispensary license.

<u>Section 2</u>. Authorized representatives of The Hub bar shall appear at the hearing set by Section 1 of this resolution and may present such testimony and evidence the licensee deems appropriate.

<u>Section 3</u>. The Clerk shall immediately notify the licensee and the affected Community Councils of this resolution.
