AN ORDINANCE AMENDING VARIOUS SECTIONS OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL
CODE TO INCREASE THE FINE AND THE MUNICIPAL BAIL SCHEDULE FOR FAILURE
TO OBEY A RED TRAFFIC SIGNAL, INCLUDING THE FAILURE TO STOP FOR STEADY
RED SIGNAL OR STEADY RED ARROW UNDER SECTION 9.14.040 AND FAILURE TO
STOP FOR A FLASHING RED LIGHT UNDER SECTION 9.14.060

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS

Section 1. Anchorage Municipal Code section 9.48.130 is hereby amended by amending the
following items of the fine and bail schedule in said section to read as follows:

9.48.130 **Vehicular offenses amenable to disposition without court appearance by
payment of a fine, offenses requiring court appearance, or offenses
correctable without fine or appearance.**

In accordance with AS 28.05.151, a citation issued for violation of any of the following
sections of this title shall be subject to disposition with payment of a fine in lieu of a court
appearance or as otherwise prescribed:

Stop for steady red signal	9.14.040.C.1	<u>200.00</u> [100.00]
Stop for steady red arrow	9.14.040.C.2	<u>200.00</u> [100.00]

Stop for flashing red light	9.14.060.A.1	<u>200.00</u> [100.00]

Section 2. Anchorage Municipal Code section 9.48.010A. is hereby amended to read as follows:


9.48.010 **Penalties.**

A. Unless another penalty is expressly provided by this title, a person convicted of
violating a provision of this title shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$300.00.

1. Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection A. of this section, the penalty for failure to obey a red traffic signal, including the failure to stop for steady red signal or steady red arrow under section 9.14.040 and failure to stop for a flashing red light under section 9.14.060 shall be \$200.

Section 2. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the Assembly.
